Being here

Most accommodation is shared. A single room may be available, but is not guaranteed. The accommodation costs 3000 yen per night and includes lunch and dinner. The fee is 1500 yen for those from 3 to 10 years old and 1000yen for those under 2 years old. Plus, you will be charged a sheet fee (200 yen per week). We are unable to accept your pets in our accommodation.

What to bring

We suggest you bring suitable clothing for work. For example, if you would like to experience farming, please bring long sleeve shirts, pants, socks, gloves, a cap, rain gear and boots if you have. You do not need to bring towels or bed linen, as we provide these.

Meals

Meals are vegetarian. You can select 500 yen or 1000 yen meal. The accommodation fee includes 500 yen lunch and dinner.
